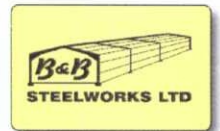
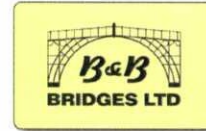

Group Environmental Policy

In particular, B&B Group's objectives are to attain ISO14001 accreditation through the implementation of systems and working practises that:

- Ensures the environmental impact of its work is assessed and minimised;
- Comply with applicable environmental legislation and regulations;
- Minimise the generation of waste, so far as this is reasonably practicable;
- Ensure that waste is segregated and recycled where possible or disposed of in responsible manner;
- Ensure substances are stored & handled safely and maintain emergency spillage procedures;
- Consider environmental performance in supplier selection;
- Adopt practicable designs and operational methods which minimise harm to the environment;
- Avoid creating nuisance;
- Seek continual improvement in environmental performance;
- Promote environmentally responsible working with our employees in the delivery of their duties.

These objectives are pursued through a variety of measures, including the development and implementation of appropriate systems and procedures, the provision of staff training as appropriate, and the monitoring and review of performance.
